PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Mimo Warto is a visual artist working in the capital region, whose practice is centered around oil painting and dedicated studio work. Although the primary focus remains on oil paints, Warto takes a research-oriented approach to art, also exploring other materials and mediums. Form is constructed cumulatively and relationally through material consciousness and historical inquiry. Warto's practice can be described as emotional realism, where reality is recognizable, yet subjective experience reshapes the relationships between space, time, and scale.
